ZOE HOPE WALK 2010

12 People x \$30 = Generations of Change

Imagine a 14-year old girl crying herself to sleep each night because she has nothing to feed the brothers and sisters in her care. **Imagine** a 15-year old boy living on the streets and eating from garbage to survive. Millions of children in Africa do not have to imagine these desperate situations, because they live in a land where every 14 seconds a child is orphaned due to HIV/AIDS. But there is hope.

ZOE Ministry comes to the aid of orphans and child-led families like these through ZOE's Orphan Empowerment Project. Orphan Empowerment surrounds these young people with the love of Christ and equips them to free themselves from the cycle of poverty and dependency within two to three years. Today the young girl no longer cries herself to sleep, and the teenage boy lives at home with his two brothers. ZOE provided life-giving skills and brought them into a community of love and support. Now they provide for themselves.

Imagine youth across the nation partnering with empowered orphans in Africa to bring thousands more orphans into this transformative journey. This vision will become reality on Friday, December 3, the eve of **Hope Walk 2010**. Hundreds of Hope Walkers in Kenya, orphans who have already graduated from ZOE's Orphan Empowerment, will complete a 10K walk with the financial partnership of American youth teammates and sponsors. Proceeds will introduce hundreds of new families into the Orphan Empowerment Project.

As the Hope Walkers begin their walk in Kenya (daytime in Africa), youth teammates from Sunrise UMC will join with other Raleigh District teammates at a lock-in at **White Plains UMC, Cary on Friday, December 3 at 9:00 pm EST**. Throughout the night they will connect live with the walkers in Kenya and with lock-in sites across the southern states through web-based video. Hearts will join in celebration on two continents as the youth talk with one another, worship together, and hear the grand total raised for new orphans through their unique partnership.

All that remains to make this night possible is the support of sponsors who will give monthly sponsorships of \$30 each, each supporting an entire family of orphans on the journey to empowerment for one month. Each Hope Walk youth teammate or group of teammates will raise at least twelve of these sponsorships, meaning a year of empowerment for a new family of orphans. 12 sponsors x \$30 = one year that will transform lives for generations to come.
